

The Colorado Section of the ACS (COACS) is looking for Volunteers!

The Colorado Section of the ACS seeks volunteers to engage in activities that enhance the lives of ACS members and the communities in which they live. The Fall 2017 elections are just around the corner and there are several leadership positions available on the executive committee. We will elect a Chair-elect, Secretary, 2 Councilors and 3 Alternate Councilors.

Here is a brief summary of the positions open for nominees:

- **Chair-elect:** serves as Chair Elect for 1 year (2018) prior to serving as Chair/Program Chair for the Section (2019) and as Past Chair for a year (2020) to assist the new Chair and manage elections. This is a three-year commitment (1/1/18 to 12/31/20).
- **Secretary:** manages the records of the section, records the minutes of the executive committee meetings, and prepares reports to ACS. The term is two years.
- **Councilors/Alternate Councilors:** attend executive committee and Section meetings, 2 National meetings each year (Councilors), and often serve on Regional and National ACS committees. The two persons with the highest votes will serve as Councilors for 3 years, the next two will serve 3-year terms as Alternate Councilors, and the person with the 5th highest vote total will serve 2 years as Alternate Councilor.

Please consider nominating someone, including yourself, who would be excited at the prospect of active volunteer leadership in the ACS, for any of these positions. Ballots will be finalized in late September.
