The grants are awarded to cover registration and a few other expenses associated with travel to the meeting (\$100 within 100 miles of the meeting; that is for students in Boulder, Denver, Fort Collins or Greeley), or \$200 in-state. The funding will be available in the form of reimbursements and we encourage recipients to become a member of the ACS - because this special call for applications is part of a membership drive initiative.

Each student is eligible to receive one student travel grant per calendar year. Notification of awards will be made by July 30th, 2016 (for Fall Meetings) and by December 20th, 2016 (for Spring Meetings). Grants are contingent upon acceptance. Grants will be paid to the students upon receipt of 1) conference report and 2) original receipts of conference-related expenses (e.g. meals, airfare, mileage, registration, hotel). These materials are due two weeks after the meeting to the above address. The ACS Colorado Section Student Grants Committee will hold two grant competition deadlines annually.
