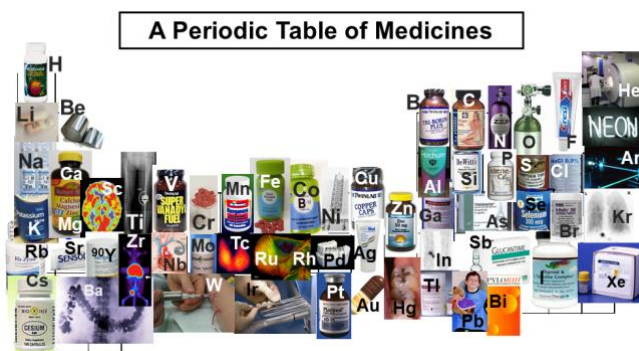
The Periodic Table of Medicines

Abstract

Each element in the periodic table is known to have properties defined by its placement, and accordingly its nuclear and electronic configuration. The properties of each element, depending on its group and row, are taught in beginning chemistry classes. However, these elements also have medicinal properties and each element forms an integral part of compound and material that is used for medicinal purposes. This is of particular interest, because only some of these elements are essential for life and others are highly toxic. The periodic table of the medicines is shown below and will be described illustrating the useful elements and their medicinal treatment(s) and reasons for such treatment(s).
